

The following examples illustrate APA citation style for selected print works. For other works see the *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association*, Sixth edition, on reserve at the Circulation Desk.

**Journal citation with up to six authors.**

**In-text citation:**

...elderly patients fear MRI tests (Armony & Dolan, 2002) and require follow-up ...

**Reference List:**

Armony, J. L., & Dolan, R. J. (2002). Modulation of spatial attention by fear-conditioned stimuli: An event-related MRI study. *Neuropsychologia*, 40, 817–826.

*Note: If each issue of a journal begins on page 1, give the issue number in parentheses after the volume number.*

**Journal citation seven or more authors.**

**In-text citation:**

... meta-analysis shows the Beck Depression Inventory (Beck, et al. 2008) to have validity...

**Reference List:**

**Newspaper citation.**

**In-text citation:**

...prescriptions of antidepressants to youths are undergoing scrutiny (Schultz, 2008) by the

### **Book.**

#### **In-text citation:**

...Sigmund Freud, recognized as one of the most familiar figures (Davis, 2007) in psychology...

#### **Reference List:**

### **Book chapter.**

#### **In-text citation:**

...The subjective well-being of college students (Haybron, 2008) has been found

#### **Reference List:**

### **Reference book.**

### **Entry in a reference book.**

#### **In-text citation:**

Though it is not completely understood how phobias develop (Bergmann, 1994) they...
