| Admission Profile | Typically, traditional undergraduate students considered for transfer admission have: a minimum GPA of at least 3.0 at their previous institution taken a rigorous load of 15 credits per semester for a full academic year earned As or Bs in most of their classes. Most admitted students had a GPA of at least 3.5. | Typically, students in the College of Professional Studies: Have prior college credit and/or an associate degree. Are working professionals who are seeking to complete their degree in a flexible, accelerated manner. |
| Admissions Process and Transfer Credits | Application fee waived. A simplified transfer application specifically for currently enrolled Cabrini students will be posted to Villanova's transfer website and available starting December 15, 2023 . Students will be notified of admission decisions on a rolling basis. Villanova commits to an expedited review of Cabrini transfer applicants to provide an admission decision as quickly as possible, and not later than May 1 . To expedite the review process, students will self-report their Spring 2024 grades. Villanova will retain the right to rescind an admission decision if a student performs poorly in their spring semester. Transfer credits are typically capped at a maximum of 61 . Students applying with more than 61 credits will be considered on a case-by- case basis. | Application fee waived. A simplified application specifically for currently enrolled Cabrini students will be posted to Villanova's CPS website and available starting September 15, 2023 . Students will be notified of admission decisions on a rolling basis, de- pending on their program of interest. Transfer credits are typically capped at a maximum of 90. |
| Financial Considerations | For both traditional undergraduate transfers and applicants to College of Professional Studies: • Financial aid or scholarship awards from Cabrini will not be transferable to Villanova. • Students should add "Villanova University" to their FAFSA. Traditional undergraduate transfer students must also complete the College Board's CSS Profile to be eligible for financial aid at Villanova. For College of Professional Studies only, a Merit Tuition Rate reduction is available for transferring Cabrini students: • 20% Merit Tuition Reduction for those students with a 3.0-3.49 overall G.P.A. • 25% Merit Tuition Reduction for those students with a 3.5-4.0 overall G.P.A. | |
