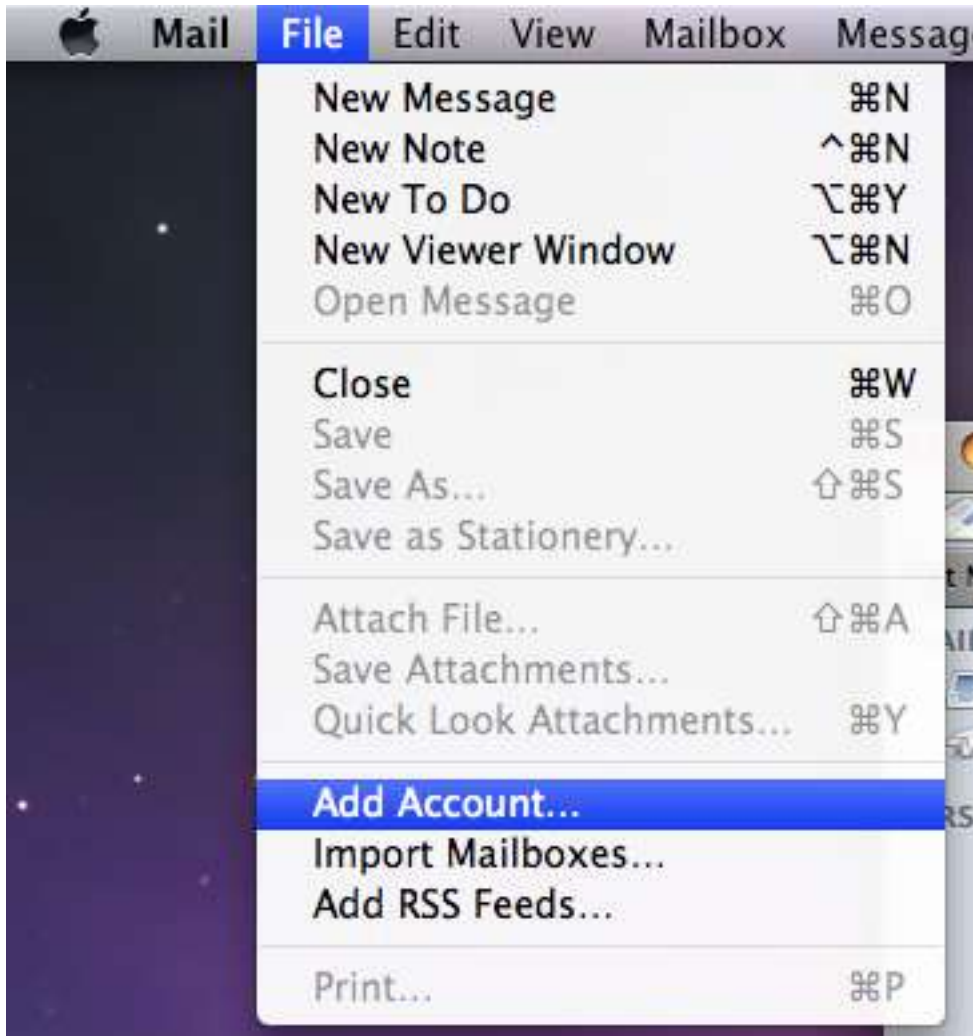


Adding a Cabrini Account to Mail on OS X 10.5

Step 1

With Mail open, navigate to the “File” drop down menu and select “Add Account”



Step 2

At the Add Account screen, enter your Cabrini Email address (abc123@cabrini.edu) followed by your normal Cabrini Password.

You'll be guided through the necessary steps to set up an additional mail account.


Step 3

Change the Account Type to IMAP.

For the Incoming Mail Server, use `imap.cabrini.edu`.

Your User Name and password should already be entered correctly.

If you are not able to continue at this step, make sure to double check you have entered your Cabrini User ID and password correctly.
