Medical Services Available

- Evaluation and treatment of illness or injury
- Wellness screenings
- Physical examinations
- Certain immunizations
- Health counseling
- Laboratory services
- Allergy injections
- Referral to specialized medical services
- First-aid supplies

Emergencies

- In case of serious emergency, students are sent to area hospitals.
- Students are accountable for all hospital fees.
- Students who are seriously ill when Health Services is closed are advised to call Public Safety at 610-902-8245 for an immediate course of action.

Fees

- Visits to Health Services are free to all students, whether part-time, full-time, commuter, resident, or grad student.
- A nominal fee may be charged for dispensing of certain prescription drugs, some over-the-counter medications, and supplies.
- A fee of \$25 is charged for a physical exam.
- Allergy injections are \$5 each, with a maximum of \$10 per visit.
- There is a fee charged for flu shots when available.

Fees may be paid at the time of service or put onto the student's account at the end of each month.

Access to Students' Records

- Parents do not have access to student's health records without written permission of the student.

Immunization Forms

- Immunization forms must be submitted to Health Services by July 15.
- If a student must wait until a later date to receive a physical exam due to insurance restraints, please notify the Health Services office so that a notation can be placed in the student's chart. This does not affect the student's class registration.

Flu Shots

- Offered each fall for a reasonable fee
- Especially important for those with chronic illnesses (asthma, respiratory illness, etc.).
- When shots are available, information will be posted on the Health Services website and around campus.

Encourage your student to get a flu shot.

Insurance

- All incoming full-time undergraduate students must have health insurance, whether private or Cabrini-sponsored.

- Deadline to waive: June 24, 2011

If a student has not waived by June 24, 2011, automatic enrollment in the school plan will necessitate the annual premium being placed onto the student's account with the July 2011 billing cycle.
