ART+EFFECT POSTER CONTEST

Exhibition at Cabrini

The Visual + Performing Arts Department at Cabrini University sponsored Art + Effect, its fifth annual poster contest for high school students. Students in grades 10–12 submitted conceptual posters designed to promote community. Due to COVID-19, the world has struggled with maintaining a sense of community as life pivoted to being physically distant and learning virtually. Art + Effect called for student poster submissions to focus on solutions, and the positive impact community has on society as changemakers.

This year, Cabrini received 126 student entries from 12 high schools in Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and Illinois. Entries were judged based on originality, craftsmanship, and thematic message by Michele Cooper, Partner at Cooper Graphic Design, Angelina Lippert, Chief Curator at Poster House, and Frances Yllana, Experience Director at projekt202. From those submissions, the judges chose 15 posters for the exhibition. The finalists are listed on the right in alphabetical order. Carlie Clevestine was the recipient of the Best of Show award and a \$500 Visa Gift Card.

The selected works will be displayed in an exhibition in the Gorevin Gallery at Cabrini University until January 12, 2022.
