The Visual + Performing Arts Department at Cabrini University sponsored Art + Effect, its sixth annual poster contest for high school students. Students in grades 9-12 submitted conceptual posters designed to promote the environment. The Earth is our home. The environment contains all the necessary resources to survive. Taking care of the environment ensures we have access to food, water, and shelter. Art + Effect is a call-to-action for students to serve as changemakers.

This year, Cabrini received 71 student entries from 11 high schools in Pennsylvania and New Jersey. Entries were judged based on originality, craftsmanship, and thematic message by the esteemed panel comprised of: Randy Clark, Tina Galbiati and Ellen Lupton. From those submissions, the judges chose 15 posters for the exhibition. The finalists are listed on the right in alphabetical order.

The selected works will be displayed in an exhibition in the Gorevin Gallery at Cabrini University from December 11, 2022, to January 27, 2023. Students will be honored for their winning artwork, and the Best of Show recipient will be announced at the opening reception and awards ceremony on Sunday, December 11, 2022 at 1pm.
