## HONORS PROGRAM AT CABRINI

The Cabrini University **Honors Program** is dedicated to honing students' critical-thinking skills; developing their creativities and imaginations; exploring and understanding diverse theories, cultures, and traditions; and expanding students' intellectual horizons.

The Honors Program takes an integrated, inclusive, interdisciplinary approach to learning that is distinctively different from other courses.

The program strives to model lifelong learning and a Cabrinian commitment to social justice, giving students the tools they need to succeed in an academic setting and in our contemporary world.

### ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

First-year applicants with a 3.7 GPA will automatically receive an application to the Honors Program via email after receiving an acceptance to Cabrini University. The application consists of a letter of recommendation speaking to the student's character and academic ability. The Honors Program is a test-blind program and only considers SAT/ACT scores that a candidate wishes to submit.

Students who do not fit these criteria but would like to be considered for the program should contact an admissions representative.

### ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

In order to graduate with the Honors Program distinction and to have "Honors Program Completed" noted on their transcripts and diplomas, students must complete the following requirements:

- H-ECG 100—Honors Engagements with the Common Good
- H-COL 101—Honors College Success Seminar
- A select first-year Honors course
- A total of four additional upper-level Honors courses offered in a variety of subjects and disciplines
- An *optional* senior thesis seminar and relevant project that showcases Honors-quality scholarship in the student's major(s)

To remain in good standing with the program, students must achieve a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher, a grade of B or higher in each of those additional upper-level courses and take at least one Honors course, each academic year.
