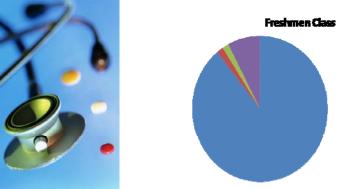


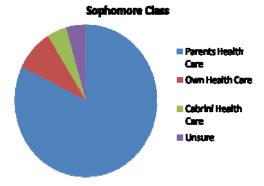
Nearly 16% of the American population are living without health insurance.

Average Health Insurance Costs for an adult is \$1800 a year.

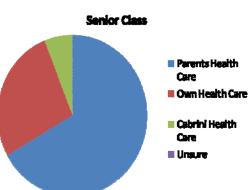

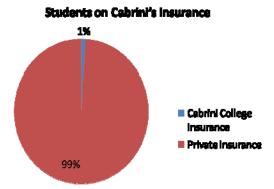
Not all jobs offer health insurance, and many college students are left without insurance during their Junior or Senior years when they are often dropped from their parents health insurance.
