



## Just Healthcare

Universal healthcare is a system by which health care is provided to all citizens living under a governed region and is publicly funded via taxation.

### ➔ Did you Know??

- Canadians live three years longer on average than Americans.
- There are 4 times as many health care lobbyists in Washington as there are members of Congress.
- 90% of Americans believe the American health care system needs fundamental change.
- Two-thirds of Americans believe the federal government should guarantee universal health care for all citizens.
- The number of uninsured adults rose 60% from 2003 to 2007.

### ➔ Your illness could mean profit:

- The top CEO makes \$1.6 Billion dollars per year of your health. The more claims they deny, the more they make.
- There are 138 total health insurance companies located with in the United States right now
- There are currently 37 countries that employ universal health care successfully.
- Four of the 37 countries successfully run Universal Health Care because of war with America

### ➔ The Uninsured:

- There are 47 million people in America currently uninsured
- 80% of those who are uninsured are employed full time
- 1/3 of uninsured American reported that they were unable to fill a prescription drug in the last year because of cost
- 20% of the uninsured say that the emergency room is there normal source of care
- 50% of non-elderly uninsured adults are less likely to receive preventive care
- 7 out of 10 people claim bankruptcy due to medical cost, even with insurance
- 38% of college age students are with out health insurance
