Cabrini welcomes the full participation of individuals with disabilities in our programs, services, and activities and is firmly committed to offering support and appropriate accommodations to qualified students. Our encouraging and inclusive community is here to help you succeed.

To be eligible for the support services and accommodations provided by the Accessibility Resource Center (ARC), you must have an identified disability as defined by the ADA/Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act. Disclosure of a disability is voluntary, and disability-related information is confidential and does not become part of your academic record.

SERVICES INCLUDED WITH TUITION:

- Intake meeting with ARC Director/Assistant Director prior the start of the start of the semester to review documentation and discuss the accommodation process.
- Delivery of ADA accommodation letter for student to provide instructors each semester. Student is primarily responsible for communication with instructors.
- Up to three 30-minute meetings each semester with a Student Accessibility Specialist for self-advocacy skills, disability-related learning support, and review of grades.
 - Referrals to Academic Enrichment for peer tutoring, writing, and math support.
- Assistance with housing accommodations for ARC resident students, in collaboration with Residence Life.
- ARC homework/study room hours available during the semester.

ACCESS PLUS PROGRAM:

***Fee for service program
\$1200 per semester**

In addition to services included with tuition the Access Plus Program Offers:

- Up to twenty-five meetings each semester with a Student Accessibility Specialist for additional academic support; executive function skills development, assistance with transition/mentoring, subsequent family meetings to review student progress and/or concerns. Meetings are about 30-45 minutes, twice a week.
 - Student Accessibility Specialist facilitates communication between instructors and support specialists and monitors academic progress.
 - Assistance with scheduling appointments for professional math and writing tutoring sessions.
 - Priority registration for classes.
- Early move-in and orientation for First-Year students.

**Fee is subject to change. The Access Plus Program has a limited number of spots available and students are encouraged to apply by June 15th, in order to process specific requests and services.*

HOW TO OBTAIN SUPPORT SERVICES AND ACCOMMODATIONS

1. Complete the ARC Support Services Application online at cabrini.edu/arc.
2. Submit supporting documentation of your disability and/or diagnosis. Students need to provide a copy of their most recent documentation by a licensed professional that states the disability and/or diagnosis as well as recommendations for accommodations.
3. Upon submission of completed application and documentation, students will be contacted to schedule an intake meeting.

Students requesting housing accommodations should submit initial request by June 15th for the Fall semester and November 17th for the Spring semester.
