

TEACH Grant

The Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant program provides grants up to \$4,000 per academic year to students.

- TEACH Grant recipients must agree to teach for four years at a low-income school or educational service agency.
- The TEACH Grant Request must be signed annually to receive a TEACH grant.
- In addition to the Agreement to serve, students will be required to complete a TEACH Grant Entrance Counseling Session annually, before any fund will be disbursed.

Awards are based on enrollment status and will be subject to the terms of the Budget Control Act of 2011, which reduces awards by 6.9%.

The terms and conditions of this service obligation are explained in the TEACH Agreement to Serve, available at <https://studentaid.gov/app/launchTeach.action>.

IMPORTANT: if you do not complete your service obligation, all TEACH Grant funds you received will be converted to a Direct Unsubsidized Loan. Upon this conversion you must repay this loan with interest charged from the date of disbursement.

Enrollment Categories:

- Full-Time: 9 or more credits
- Half-Time: 4.5 to 8 credits
- Less Than Half-Time: fewer than 4 credits

- I understand that the TEACH Grant is to be used for educational expenses while I attend Cabrini University, and I will use the proceeds from this grant accordingly.

I also understand that this is a grant that must be repaid with back interest as a Direct Unsubsidized Loan if I do not:

1. **teach in a high need subject area**
2. **teach in a designated low-income school**
3. **teach full-time for four years within eight years of completing each teaching program**

** The TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve or Repay (Agreement) explains the terms and conditions for receiving a TEACH Grant. By signing the Agreement to Serve or Repay, you agree to these terms and conditions and acknowledge that if you do not fulfill the service obligation described in the agreement, the TEACH Grant funds you received will be converted to a Direct Unsubsidized Loan that you must repay, in full, along with interest charged from the date of each TEACH Grant disbursement**

- I understand that if the grant becomes a Direct Unsubsidized Loan, it stays a Direct Unsubsidized Loan.
- I understand that there is NO credit for part-time teaching or partial fulfillment of service.
- I authorize that the TEACH Grant funds be applied to my Cabrini University account to pay any and all charges on said account. *Any funds remaining after charges are paid will be returned to the student.*
