ACCESS YOUR CAVLIST TO PREPARE FOR YOUR FIRST-YEAR EXPERIENCE:

1. Visit the Cabrini Portal at portal.cabrini.edu.
2. Log in with your Cabrini username and password provided in the welcome letter of your Enrollment Package.
3. Select "Students" in the middle of the Cabrini Portal home page.
4. Select "Access Learn directly" in "My Courses" section.
5. Select "Courses" on the tool bar on the top of the page.
6. Select "Fall Semester 23–24."
7. Select "COL-099-OL (The CavList)—Fall 23–24."
8. Select "Start" at the top of the page and begin your checklist.

REGISTER FOR BEGINNINGS ORIENTATION

Beginnings is Cabrini's one-day summer orientation. Meet other new students, develop a sense of community, learn more about Cabrini, finalize your fall course schedule, and make friends.

COMPLETE YOUR LEARNING COMMUNITY (LC) APPLICATION

The foundational piece of Cabrini University's First-Year Experience is our Learning Community (LC) program. In addition to your intended academic major, your LC placement influences your fall course schedule.

ACADEMIC QUESTIONNAIRE

The courses you take during your first semester at Cabrini will be scheduled by an academic advisor. This Academic Questionnaire helps an advisor get important information needed to assist you in developing your fall course schedule. Please fill it out completely and carefully.

MATH PLACEMENT EXAM

Students at Cabrini may be required to take up to two math courses, depending on their current skill level. The purpose of the Math Placement Exam is to help the Mathematics faculty place you in the level of mathematics appropriate for you when you enter Cabrini. Please note that advisors cannot develop your fall course schedule if you have not completed the Math Placement Exam.

COMPLETE YOUR HOUSING APPLICATION (IF YOU PLAN TO LIVE ON CAMPUS)

Apply by June 2 to ensure your roommate preferences are considered; students who apply after June 2 will be placed based on availability, and roommate preference considerations will be limited.

APPLY FOR ACCESSIBILITY RESOURCE CENTER (ARC) SUPPORT (IF DESIRED)

Visit cabrini.edu/ARC to submit an Accessibility Resource Center (ARC) Services Application and/or Housing Accommodation Application and any subsequent documentation so that we can assist with your specific requests and services. Once your materials have been submitted, email ARC@cabrini.edu to schedule an appointment with the ARC.

REGISTER FOR YOUR ID CARD

Your Cabrini ID card is required and provides access to the residence halls, dining area, library, and other services.

To register for your card, submit your name, Cabrini ID number, and a high school class or passport photo to IDcard@cabrini.edu. The photo should clearly show your head, including your face, and upper shoulders. DO NOT wear a hat, sunglasses, or anything that obstructs the view of your head and face, or use any type of photo filter or frame.
