Application Process

ELIGIBILITY

The John and Linda Heiberger Study Abroad Award is open to all Cabrini University business majors, in good academic standing, who meet the criteria below.

- The applicant is a declared business major at Cabrini College
- The applicant has applied for either a short term study abroad award or a semester-long study abroad award.
- The applicant has been approved for either the short term study abroad trip or the semester-long study abroad program
- The study abroad program can be used during the Fall, Spring or Summer semesters
- Awards will be based on financial need

APPLICATION

Students will need to submit the following in addition to completing the attached application:

- Unofficial copy of academic transcripts
(Official transcripts will be reviewed by the Business Department)
- Essay
 - No more than 1,000 word essay; must be typed and double spaced
 - In this essay, you must describe the importance of multicultural/international study and what you expect to gain from your study abroad experience.
- Completed application with essay and transcripts must be submitted to Dr. Erin McLaughlin by December 10. Award recipients will be notified by January 31st.
