


WANT TO GET OFF CAMPUS?



FINANCIAL AID

We offer aid in the form of merit scholarships for high school academic performance, SAT/ACT scores, and extracurricular activities, in addition to need-based aid based on each family's financial situation. **But financial aid is just one of the ways we make Cabrini affordable.** We offer opportunities for students to earn their degree faster—high school students can take college-level courses while they're juniors or seniors in high school, and students in some of our joint programs can shave a year off their undergraduate program while taking classes toward a graduate degree.
